


# Olli - Planes



Morgantown Municipal Airport (MGW) currently offers daily flights to Baltimore-Washington International (BWI) in Maryland and Pittsburgh International Airport in Pennsylvania accessing nearly 1,000 connecting flights to domestic and international destinations. Flights are operated by Southern Airways.



The North Central West Virginia Airport (CKB) is a public airport owned and operated by the Benedum Airport Authority. Located in Bridgeport, West Virginia the airport proudly serves the communities of Clarksburg, Fairmont, Morgantown, Weston, and the surrounding region. The airport is currently served by two commercial airlines; **Allegiant and United Express**. **Allegiant offers less than daily service to Orlando/Sanford, FL and Myrtle Beach, SC while United Express offers global connectivity through their hubs of Chicago O’Hare and Washington Dulles.** It encompasses approximately 665 acres and is home to the longest commercial service runway in West Virginia at 7,800 feet.



**The Mid-Atlantic Aerospace Complex (MAAC)** markets and promotes the capabilities in aviation and aerospace of the North Central West Virginia Airport along with its component members to government, industrial clients and prospects throughout the world. The MAAC's complement of aerospace industry services plays a major role in the region's economic development and **provides first-rate maintenance, overhaul, manufacturing, and training services for the aerospace industry. Today, the complex employs more than 1,300 people in aviation-related jobs and has an economic impact of over \$1 billion.**

#### **Aurora**

Aurora Flight Sciences is a leader in the development and manufacturing of advanced unmanned systems and aerospace vehicles. The West Virginia facility is the center of Aurora's composite manufacturing work for military aircraft, with the RQ-4 Global Hawk/Triton and the CH-53K King Stallion providing the foundation. In addition, the facility is also the production base for numerous composite airframe parts of the Bell 525 helicopter. First established in 1994, Aurora's WV manufacturing facilities have grown over the years to a total 125,000 sq. feet between three buildings.

The plant’s employees produce approximately 7% of each C-130 aircraft. The assemblies include a major portion of the forward fuselage, the cargo ramp, leading edges of the wings, major wing components, and the wheel well fairings into which the main landing gears retract during flight.
